# Summary Public Assessment Report

*Dalbavancin Accord*

This is a summary of the public assessment report (PAR) for Dalbavancin Accord. It explains how the assessment was made and why the authorisation was recommended as well as the conditions of use. It is not intended to provide practical advice on how to use the product.

For practical information about the use of the product, patients should read the package leaflet or contact their doctor or pharmacist.

## **What is Dalbavancin Accord and what is it used for?**

The product is a 'generic medicine'. This means that it is similar to a 'reference medicine' already authorised in the European Union (EU) called Xydalba.

Dalbavancin Accord is used to treat adults and children aged 3 months and over with infections of the skin or in the layers of flesh below the skin.

## **How does Dalbavancin Accord work?**

Dalbavancin Accord contains the active substance dalbavancin, which is an antibiotic of the glycopeptide group.

Dalbavancin Accord works by killing certain bacteria, which can cause serious infections. It kills these bacteria by interfering with the formation of bacterial cell walls.

Dalbavancin Accord can be used in combination with other types of antibiotics, if necessary.

## **How is Dalbavancin Accord used?**

The pharmaceutical form is Powder for concentrate for solution for infusion for intravenous use.

Please read section 3 of the package leaflet for detailed information on dosing recommendations, the route of administration, and the duration of treatment.

The medicine can only be obtained with a prescription in Sweden.

## **What benefits of Dalbavancin Accord have been shown in studies?**

No additional studies were needed as the product is a generic medicine that is given by intravenous injection and contains the same active substance as the reference medicine, Xydalba.

## **What are the possible side effects from Dalbavancin Accord?**

Because the product is a generic medicine, its benefits and possible side effects are taken as being the same as the reference medicine.

## **Why is Dalbavancin Accord approved?**

It was concluded that, in accordance with EU requirements, the product has been shown to have comparable quality and is considered to be therapeutically equivalent to the reference medicine. Therefore, the Swedish Medical Products Agency decided that, as for Xydalba, the benefits are greater than its risks and recommended that it can be approved for use.

**What measures are being taken to ensure the safe and effective use of Dalbavancin Accord?**

A risk management plan has been developed to ensure that the product is used as safely as possible. Based on this plan, safety information has been included in the summary of product characteristics and the package leaflet, including the appropriate precautions to be followed by healthcare professionals and patients.

Known side effects are continuously monitored. Furthermore, new safety signals reported by patients/healthcare professionals will be monitored/reviewed continuously as well.
